

KEVIN M. WEEKS BIOGRAPHY

Kevin M. Weeks is the author of a collection of Crime Fiction novels titled The Street Life Series, which is also categorized under African American Literature as well as Mystery. In January 2008, the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) approved for Kevin M. Weeks to use the name The Street Life Series®.

The publisher for The Street Life Series by Kevin M. Weeks is Xlibris Corporation. Because Urban Fiction books are also appealing to teenagers, Kevin M. Weeks includes a Parental Advisory statement in all of his novels. Also, he uses words of wisdom to guide his main characters through their journey in each novel of the book as a way of incorporating lessons learned about living a life on the streets. The first quote Weeks cited in his debut novel was "Always do what you always did; and you will always get what you always got. --- Anonymous." Each novel has a quote, which Weeks dubs as Old School wisdom.

==BIOGRAPHY==

Kevin M Weeks was born the second of four children to Anthony and Signe Weeks in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in the late 1960's. Even though he spent much of his youth in and out of detention centers, Kevin M. Weeks became an avid reader as an adult. This led to him finding a passion to write books about lessons learned from his life's experiences. His writings are derived from The New Jack Swing era of R&B and Hip Hop music, which plays a major role in the storyline of his novels. Because Weeks wanted to be a police detective when he was a child, his novels incorporate the key elements of crime fiction.

In 2008, Kevin M. Weeks launched a campaign titled "Stay Off The Streets," which focuses on foster care teens who "age out" of the foster care system at 18 years old. He supports charities and organizations that provide the programs for these teens to have a smooth transition into adulthood.
